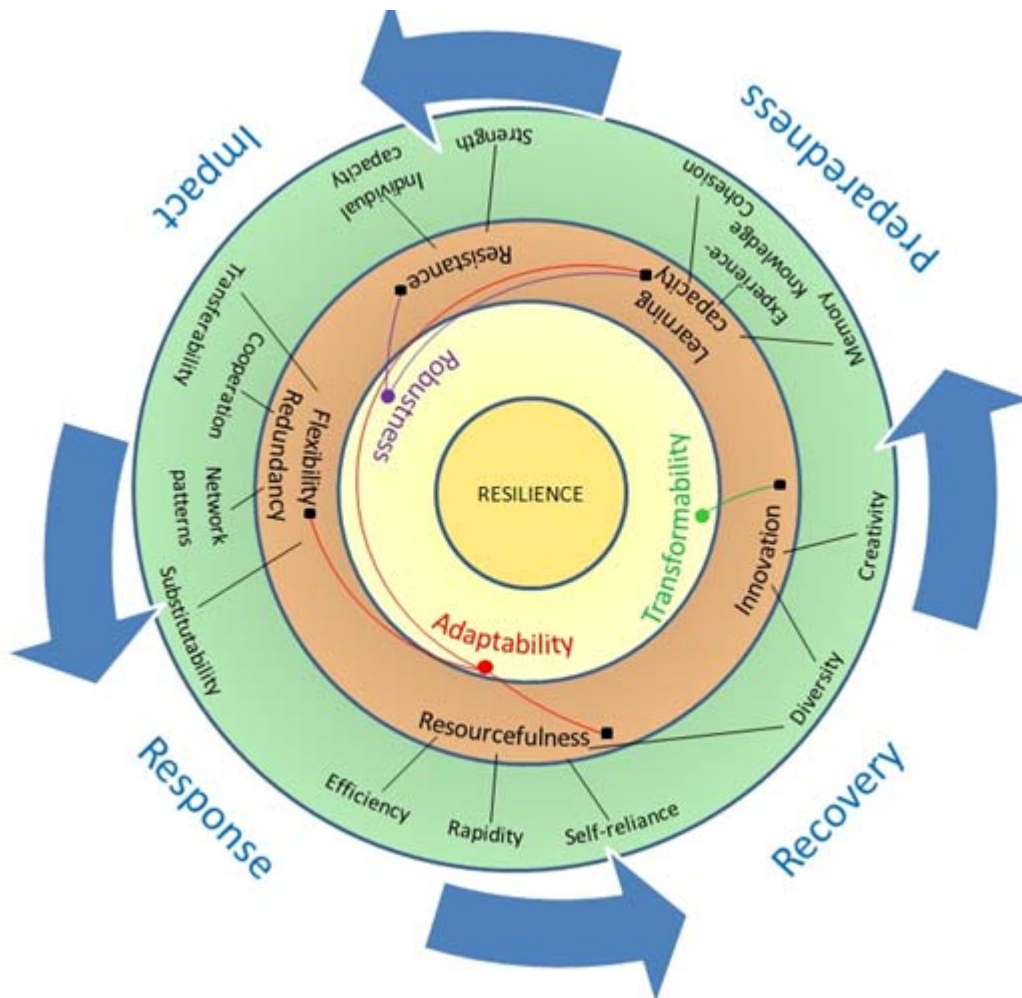
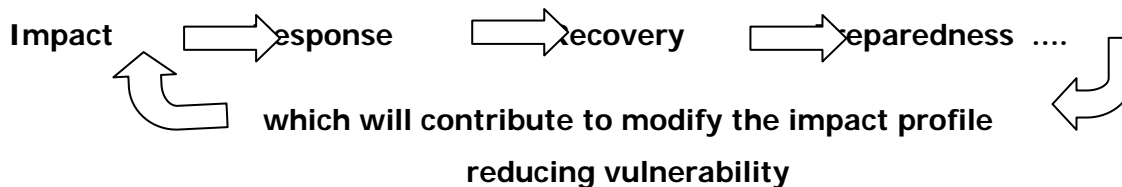


Turning resilience into operational terms: do you recognize the following image? Can you explain it?



The image shows the “ring model of resilience” as it has been developed in the ENSURE Project.

The key dimensions of resilience have been arranged into a circular scheme, following the main phases of the disaster cycle:



Moreover, within the circular scheme, the dimensions have been sorted into concentric circles that, starting from the most internal one in which resilience has been placed, drive toward a progressive specification of the resilience concept.
